A two-day training workshop to sharpen skills and build a network on forest communication in the Asia-Pacific region

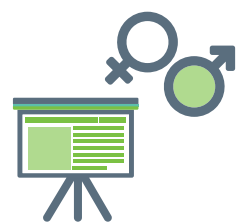
### Join our network of skilled forest communicators!
