Introduction and background

Forest resources are vital for forest dependent communitiest providing the livelihood options and food security. By providing the legal access through Social Forestry/ Community forestry program, positive feedback have been received among others decrease deforestation rate, reduce poverty, and improve economic livelihood. Unfortunately, the emerging pandemic has halted the progress of SF/ CF in the region, particularly Indonesia that has ambitious target in SF and hit hardly by the Covid-19.

During the pandemic period, over the last six months, there is an increase in food consumption while production is declining due to several restriction measurement that has been taken in order to reduce the spread of the virus. Other economic activities such as tourism in SF/CF areas are drastically declining that led the SF/CF group to become more vulnerable.

With the economic development being stall, there are less job opportunities at the cities which drive people to return to the rural areas. This condition increase the burden of the forest because people is looking their income from the forest. Under such circumstances, the Social Forestry Program that provides access to forest management in the village, supported by assistance to increase capacity and bring opportunity for investment and marketing cooperation, can help resolve the lay-off problem, while providing a driving force for the movement of the rural economy through food security with agroforestry pattern. This event will be hosted by DG of Social Forestry and Environmental Partnership and RECOFT.

Event objectives

The event will discuss the experiences of social forestry activities as key experts in the field in relation to mitigate the covid-19 impacts. Based on this, it will explore actions that are needed to strengthen the capacity and capability of social forestry actors including forest farmer.

The event will take place in a "Talk-show" format, with facilitator-led questions to the panelists, followed by a short session of audience questions. During the Talk-show, there will be the short video screening about Social Forestry.
